

UNO EDGEWATER RESIDENT REWARDS PROGRAM PRIVACY POLICY

HEDGEHOG MANAGER LLC ("**Hedgehog**", "**we**", "**our**", or "**us**"), as the manager of the Uno Edgewater Resident Rewards Program ("**The Program**"), is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

1. **OUR APPROACH TO PRIVACY**

This privacy policy sets out how we collect, use and share data that identifies or is associated with you ("**personal information**") as a result of you participating in the Program, or using or using the investment portal <https://app.hedgehog-invest.com> and the mobile applications available through various third party app stores (collectively referred to as the "**Sites**") or otherwise interacting with us (whether online or offline).

2. **ABOUT US**

Hedgehog is a Delaware limited liability company, registered at 850 New Burton Road, Suite 201, Dover, County of Kent, Delaware 19904. Hedgehog is the data controller of the personal information we hold about you.

3. **PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU AND HOW WE USE IT**

The table at Annex 1 sets out the categories of personal information we collect about you and how we use that information. The table also lists the legal basis which we rely on to process the personal information.

More generally, we:

- (a) collect personal information that you voluntarily submit to us, such as your name, address, email address and contact details, when you register with us, use our Sites and our services, or otherwise interact with us in the course of our business activities;
- (b) collect personal information you are required to provide us as part of our client onboarding procedures and financial suitability checks, such as address, tax residency, social security number, identification documents, investor profile information; some of this information may be collected from your Landlord to make it easier for you to register with Hedgehog.
- (c) collect personal information about you from third parties, such as identity verification providers, reference agencies, diligence providers, social networks, public databases (where permitted by law), third party service providers, our advertising partners and our other business partners where we carry out joint business activities; and
- (d) if you elect to participate in the Program we will collect and process information about the initiation, renewal, performance and termination of your lease from your landlord and/or building owner (such as the lease terms, lease renewal, whether the lease is still active, your expected rental payments, whether you have paid rental payments in full and on time and whether you have complied with all the terms of your lease agreement). We will process this information to enable us to validate and issue any resident tokens due to you under the terms of the Program; and

(e) may also collect certain personal information automatically, including in relation to how you access and use the Sites, technical information regarding the device you use to access the Sites and the way in which you interact with our emails and newsletters (such as whether you open these).

We use the information we collect about you to correspond with you, perform our agreements with you, carry out marketing activities and our day-to-day business activities and operations (as described in greater detail in Annex 1).

We may link or combine the personal information we collect about you and the information we collect automatically. This allows us to provide you with a personalised experience regardless of how you interact with us.

We will indicate to you where the provision of certain personal information is required in order for us to provide you with certain features of the Site. If you choose not to provide such personal information, we may not be able to provide you with access to certain aspects of the Site.

4. PROCESSING OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS

We collect and process Social Security Numbers (“SSNs”) only where it is necessary for the performance of our services (for example, to verify your identity) or where it is required by law (for example, to comply with tax reporting requirements). We recognize the sensitivity and important of SSNs and have implemented measures to protect the confidentiality and integrity of the SSNs we collect.

We restrict access to SSNs to employees and agents who need access to such information to provide products or services to you or to allow us to fulfil our legal obligations. We have implemented physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards designed to protect against unauthorized access or disclosure of SSNs.

We prohibit the unlawful disclosure of SSNs and will only disclose such data to third parties and service providers as required by law, or where they are contractually obligated to protect this information and use it only on our behalf.

We will retain SSNs only for as long as required to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements. After this, the SSNs will be securely deleted or anonymized.

We require any third parties who might have access to SSNs as part of providing services to us to adhere to similar standards of security and confidentiality.

5. DATA RETENTION

We will store the personal information we collect about you for no longer than necessary for the purposes set out at section 3 in accordance with our legal obligations and legitimate business interests.

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal information, we consider the amount, nature and sensitivity of the personal information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of your personal information, the purposes for which we process your personal information and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal, regulatory, tax, accounting or other requirements.

6. RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may also share your personal information with the following (as required in accordance with the uses set out in at section 3 above):

- (a) **Service providers and advisors:** we may share your personal information with third party vendors and other service providers that perform services for us or on our behalf, which may include providing advertising, marketing, data hosting, CRM, IT system administration, banking, advertising, identity verification services, fraud prevention, tokenization services, and payment and analytics services.
- (b) **Landlord and/or building owner:** we may share your investor information with your landlord and/or building owner as necessary in order for them to oversee and evaluate the performance of the Program. This will include information such as the details of tokens claimed, issued and vested for each resident.
- (c) **Token Issuers:** we may share your investor information with the token issuer entity and such other third parties as necessary to allow us to operate the Program and you to exercise your privileges in relation to a particular tokenized investment.
- (d) **Purchasers and third parties in connection with a business transaction:** your personal information may be disclosed to third parties in connection with a transaction, such as a merger, sale of assets or shares, reorganisation, financing, change of control or acquisition of all or a portion of our business.
- (e) **Law enforcement, regulators, governmental authorities and other parties for legal reasons:** we may share your personal information with third parties as required by law or if we reasonably believe that such action is necessary to (i) comply with financial or tax reporting obligations; (ii) comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement; (iii) detect and investigate illegal activities and breaches of agreements; and/or (iv) exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of Hedgehog or others.
- (f) **Other members of the Hedgehog group:** we may share your personal information with our affiliates (for example, where they provide services on our behalf) or where such sharing is otherwise necessary in accordance with the uses set out in Annex 1.

In addition, we may share your personal information with other third parties if you have provided your consent for us to do so.

7. ANONYMOUS DATA

We may anonymise and aggregate any of the personal information we collect about you (so that it does not directly identify you). We may use anonymised information for purposes that include testing our IT systems, research, data analysis, improving our Sites and developing new products and features. We may also share such anonymised information with others.

8. MARKETING AND ADVERTISING

From time to time, we may contact you with information about Hedgehog and its affiliates, including for the purposes of sending you marketing messages, inviting you to events we believe may be of interest to you and asking for your feedback.

We will only send you marketing messages if you have given us your consent to do so, unless consent is not required under applicable law (e.g., when marketing to corporate email addresses or in certain circumstances where we have a pre-existing customer relationship with you).

We also participate in interest-based advertising and use third party advertising companies to serve you targeted advertisements based on your online browsing history and your interests. To do this, we or our advertising partners may collect information about how you use or connect to the Sites, or the types of other websites, social media services, content and ads that you (or others using your device) visit or view or connect to our Sites so that we or our advertising partners may play or display ads on the Sites, on other websites, apps or services you may use, and on other devices you may use.

You can withdraw your consent or opt out of receiving further communications at a later date by clicking on the unsubscribe link at the bottom of our marketing emails.

9. **STORING AND TRANSFERRING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

Security. We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, change or damage. For example, we use, as appropriate, firewalls, access controls, policies and other procedures to protect information from unauthorised access.

International Transfers of your Personal Information. We may transfer your personal information to countries outside of the United States.

In some cases, this might result in your personal information being transferred to a country not recognised as having an adequate level of protection for personal data. These international transfers of your personal information will be made pursuant to appropriate safeguards, such as standard data protection clauses adopted by the UK government or the European Commission. If you wish to enquire further about the safeguards used, please contact us using the details set out at the end of this privacy policy.

10. **YOUR RIGHTS IN RESPECT OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

In accordance with applicable privacy law, you have the following rights in respect of your personal information that we hold:

- (a) **Right of access.** You have the right to obtain access to your personal information.
- (b) **Right of portability.** You have the right, in certain circumstances, to receive a copy of the personal information you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format that supports re-use, or to request the transfer of your personal data to another person.
- (c) **Right to rectification.** You have the right to obtain rectification of any inaccurate or incomplete personal information we hold about you without undue delay.
- (d) **Right to erasure.** You have the right, in some circumstances, to require us to erase your personal information without undue delay if the continued processing of that personal information is not justified.
- (e) **Right to restriction.** You have the right, in some circumstances, to require us to limit the purposes for which we process your personal information if the continued processing of the personal information in this way is not justified, such as where the accuracy of the personal information is contested by you.
- (f) **Right to object.** You have a right to object to the processing we carry out on the basis of legitimate interests in certain circumstances. You can also object to our direct marketing activities for any reason by clicking the "unsubscribe" link set out in any marketing communication you receive.

(g) **Right to withdraw consent.** If you have provided consent to any processing of your personal information, you have a right to withdraw that consent.

Please note that the above rights are not absolute and we may be entitled to refuse requests, wholly or partly, where exceptions under the applicable law apply.

The Sites are not intended for or directed at children under the age of 18 years and we do not knowingly collect information relating to children under this age.

When we change this privacy policy in a material way, we will update the "last modified" date at the end of this privacy policy. Changes to this privacy policy are effective when they are posted on this page.
